Terravent acquires Hammelwarder Moor wind farm in Lower Saxony from Energiekontor

Bremen/Konstanz, 24 January 2019. Terravent Deutschland GmbH, a subsidiary of Terravent AG, has signed an agreement with Bremen-based Energiekontor AG to purchase the Hammelwarder Moor wind farm. The wind farm near the town of Brake on the river Weser consists of three Senvion 3.4M 114 turbines with a total height of 176 metres, the last of which was commissioned in February 2018. With a total rated output of 10.2 MW, the expected annual yield of the wind farm is over 25 million kWh, which corresponds to the requirements of more than 7,000 households. The parties have agreed not to disclose the purchase price.

Dieter Hauser, Managing Director of Terravent Deutschland GmbH, is delighted: "Thanks to the constructive and cooperative cooperation with Energiekontor, we were able to conclude the transaction before the end of 2018. Due to its proximity to the North Sea, we expect this wind farm to generate stable production revenues and additional diversification effects for our existing portfolio".

"We are pleased to have gained Terravent as a new investor for our wind farms. The contract negotiations were extremely rapid and cooperative," says Peter Szabo, CEO of Energiekontor AG.

With the purchase of the wind farm in northern Lower Saxony, Terravent is expanding its onshore wind power portfolio to 129 MW and the Group's production to over 310,000,000 kWh.

About Terravent:

Terravent Deutschland GmbH is a subsidiary of Terravent AG, a Swiss holding company with the purpose of investing in onshore wind farms in Germany and France. The Terravent Group has offices in Lucerne (Switzerland), Lyon (France) and Constance (Germany) and operates a total of 8 wind farm companies. Since its foundation in 2011, Terravent has invested more than CHF 100 million in onshore wind power and intends to further expand its portfolio. The shareholders of Terravent AG are the Swiss energy companies Axpo (23.4%), SN Energie (21.9%), ewl energie wasser luzern (ewl; 16.6%), Azienda Elettrica Ticinese (AET; 14.1%), Elektrizitätswerke des Kantons Zürich (EKZ; 14.7%) and Elektrizitätswerk des Kantons Schaffhausen AG (EKS; 9.4%).

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
